- Encourage your son/daughter to always play by the rules of the game.
- Focus on your son/daughter's efforts and performance not whether games were won or lost.
- Never yell or verbally abuse your son/daughter for losing a game or making a mistake.
- Please be aware at Boscombe Albion, the development of your son/daughter as a footballer is as important as winning.
- The decision of the match officials must not be questioned in public. Any discussion is to be via the manager.
- Parents and spectators are encouraged to make positive comments on good play and applaud your own team and the opposition.
- The only coaching that should take place is that given by the Team Manager or Assistant Manager as the players may become confused with multiple instructions.
- Cooperate and support your team's Manager. Any discussion should be made at the end of the game or an appropriate time and if possible, in private.
- Please advise the Manager as soon as possible of any injury, illness or future absence to allow appropriate action to take place.
